For uprates beyond the family groupings, changing out some components such as the Diesel Particulate Filter (DPF) and fuel injectors also becomes necessary.

Refer to the charts for guidelines on what it takes to uprate your C9, C13 or C15 Cat truck engine. Then contact your Cat engine dealer or Cat factory-authorized truck dealer for pricing and installation. They have the trained technicians to get your uprate done right and get you back on the road with the extra engine power you need.
